
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

More than 2.7 million Americans have served in Afghanistan and Iraq since late 2001. Many were in both wars. Nearly 7,000 of them died, and tens of thousands were wounded. Pulitzer Prize-winning author **C. J. Chivers** follows the long human arc of the two wars by tracing the lives of six American service members over seventeen years.

In a narrative that gathers momentum and intensity with the passage of years, *The Fighters* captures its characters' courage, commitment, and sense of purpose... and ultimately, their suffering, frustration, and moral confusion as they serve through the conflicts' escalating phases. Chivers accompanied troops over many years and on repeated tours. He has developed a deep understanding of war in our time, evident here in this moving and unforgettable account of modern warfare.
